

Login Guide: NCPG Agility Grants Application

NCPG welcomes Agility Grant applications from any U.S. based nonprofit engaging in problem gambling prevention programming. **NCPG membership is not required to apply for a grant; however, all applicants must have a YourMembership (YM) account to access the online grant application.**

If you are an NCPG member or non-member who already has an account in YourMembership (NCPG's membership platform): Please use your YourMembership credentials. [See pages 1-2 for login instructions.](#)

If you DO NOT have an account in YourMembership: You will need to register, either as a new member or as a guest account, prior to submitting a grant application. [See pages 3-6 for account creation and login instructions.](#)

If you need to add a collaborator or are added to an application as a collaborator, [see pages 6-9 for instructions on managing collaborators and joining as a collaborator.](#)

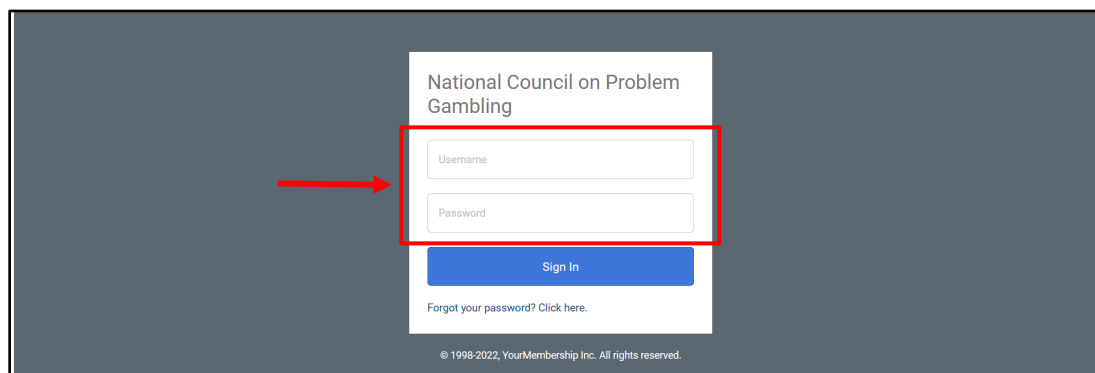

The National Council on Problem Gambling (NCPG) launched the Agility Grants program in 2022. This strategic initiative, funded by the National Football League Foundation, offers grant funding to nonprofit organizations across the United States for problem gambling prevention programs.

Problem gambling—or gambling addiction—includes all gambling behavior patterns that compromise, disrupt or damage personal, family or vocational pursuits. The symptoms include increasing preoccupation with gambling, a need to bet more money more frequently, restlessness or irritability when attempting to stop, "chasing" losses, and loss of control manifested by continuation of the gambling behavior in spite of mounting, serious, negative consequences. In extreme cases, problem gambling can result in financial ruin, legal problems, loss of career and family, or even suicide. For more information on the American Psychiatric Association's criteria for gambling addiction, please see the DSM 5 at www.psych.org.

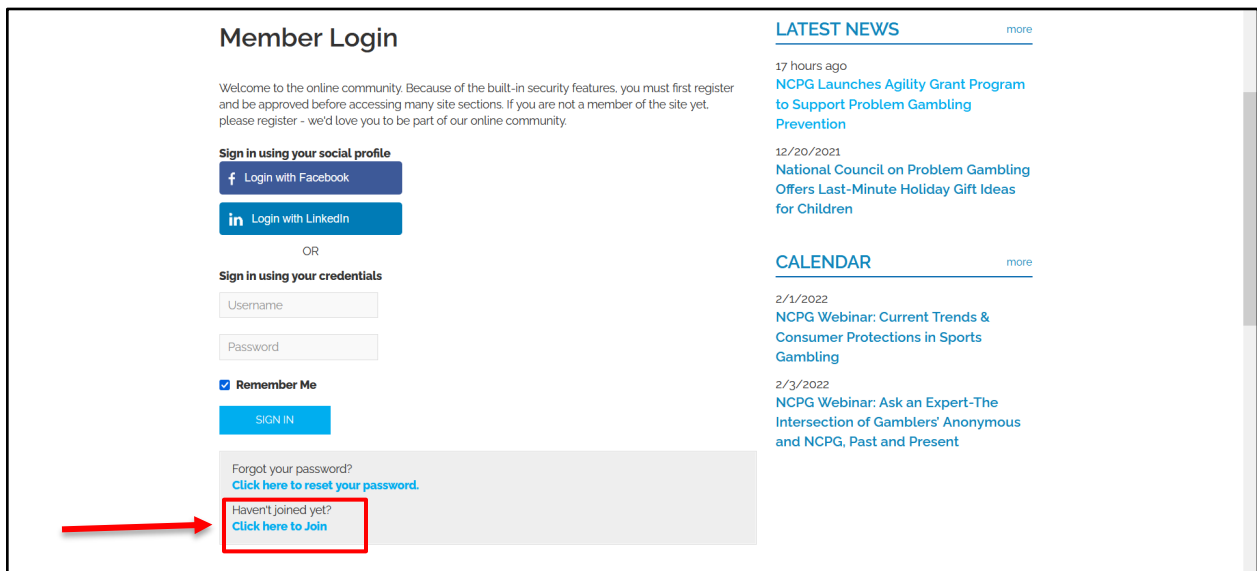
If you are NOT an NCPG member:

1. Click “Sign In” in the upper right corner.



2. Scroll down to the gray box. Under “Haven’t joined yet?” select “Click here to join”.



3. Select one of the following two options. *Note: You may submit an application from either an individual account or organization account. Pick whichever makes the most sense for your organization.*
 - a. “Guest Individual Account (no membership)”
 - b. “Guest Organization Account (no membership)”





8. Complete all the required fields in the member information form.





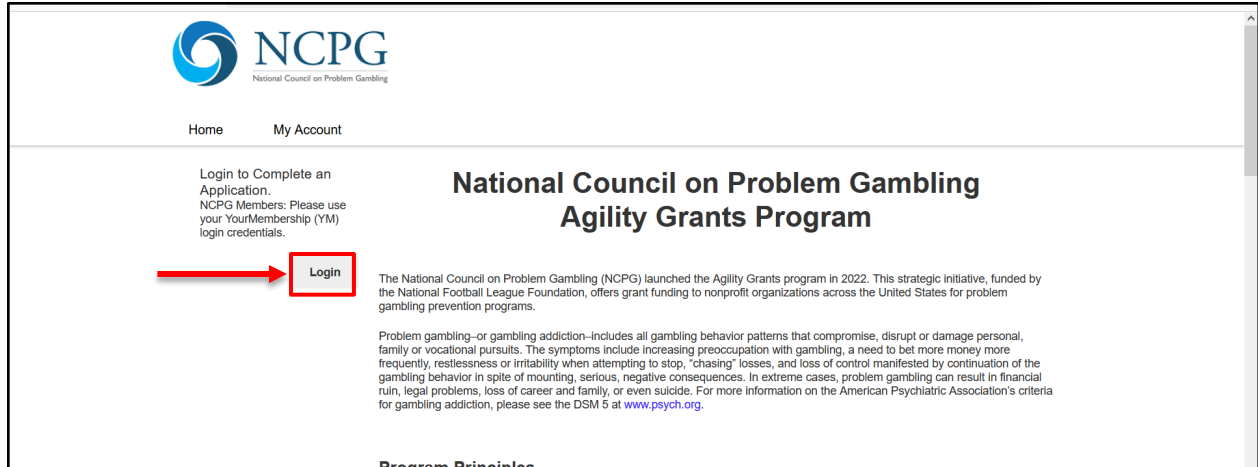

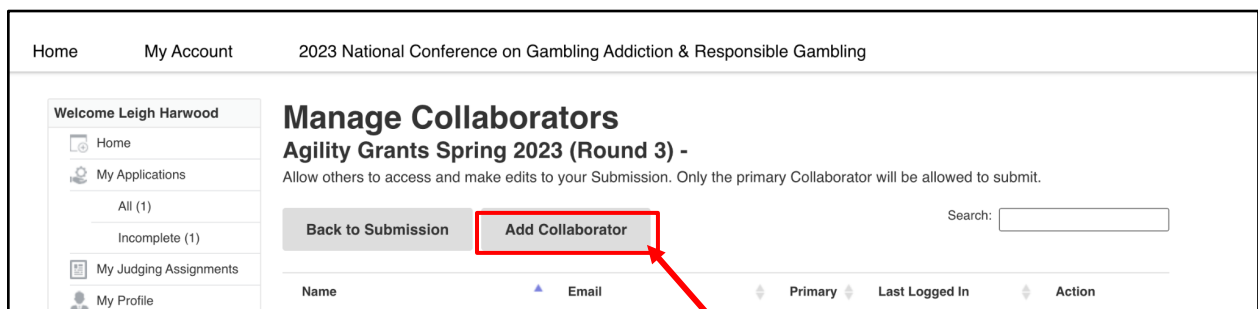


Collaborator Management Instructions (if you need to ADD a collaborator)

1. Once you have started your application, your organization can add collaborators to work on the application with you. To add a collaborator, click "Manage Collaborators".




2. Then, click "Add Collaborators".

3. Enter the first name, last name, and email address of the collaborator you want to add and click "Save". This will send an email invitation to the collaborator (at the address provided) which will prompt said collaborator to log in. **At this point, you have finished adding the collaborator.** If you would like to add more than one, repeat the process.



1. When you have been added to an application as a collaborator, you will receive an email invitation from OpenWater (example below). **Click the link to set a password and sign in to the application portal.**





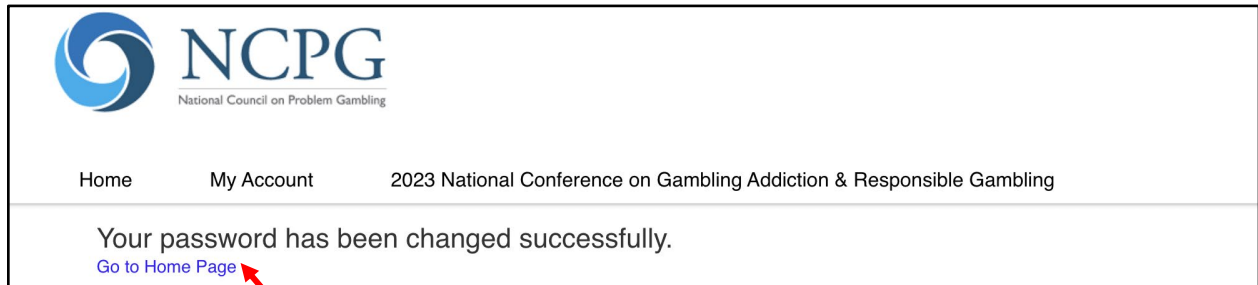

4. On the home page, you will be prompted to enter additional profile information. Your first and last name cannot be edited from what was submitted on the “Add a Collaborator” form (see above).


